SKILL LEVEL: EASY / BEGINNER



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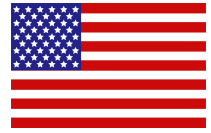
US TERMS JUMPER #1

WHAT YOU WILL NEED:

Your chosen colour palette of DK yarns Customise as you please!

4mm crochet hook

Darning needle/Finishing needle



This pattern is written in US terms.

ABBREVIATIONS:

mc - magic circle.

hdc - half double crochet.

sc - single crochet.

st - stitch.

dc - double crochet.

ch - chain.

sl st - slip stitch.

fsc - foundation single crochet.



WHAT TO DO:

Creating the base of the jumper.

Start with a mc. (or ch3 and sl st to first chain).

ROUND 1: Ch3, work 11dc into mc, sl st to join. (12)

ROUND 2: Continue with same colour yarn. Ch2, 1hdc in same st. 2hdc in every stitch around. sl st to join. (24)

ROUND 3: Continue with same colour yarn. Ch2, hdc in same st, *(hdc, hdc, 2hdc) repeat to end of round. (32)

**The first 3 rounds create the base of your apple jumper. Now to build the body and sleeves.*

Creating the body of the jumper.

**This pattern has 6x rows that form the main body of the jumper. This was intentional, to give you enough rows to get creative with your own stitch formations, colour and texture to be able to create your own version!*

ROUND 4: Continue with same colour yarn. Ch2, hdc in every stitch around (32) sl st to join, ch1 to finish and cut your colour of yarn.

ROUND 5: Join new colour yarn. Ch2, hdc in every stitch around (32) sl st to join, ch1 to finish and cut your colour of yarn.

ROUND 6: Join new colour yarn. Ch2, hdc in every stitch around (32) sl st to join, ch1 to finish and cut your colour of yarn.

ROUND 7: Join new colour yarn. Ch2, hdc in every stitch around (32) sl st to join, ch1 to finish and cut your colour of yarn.

ROUND 8: Join new colour yarn. Ch2, hdc in every stitch around (32) sl st to join, ch1 to finish and cut your colour of yarn.

ROUND 9: Join new colour yarn. Ch2, hdc in every stitch around (32) sl st to join, ch1 to finish.

Creating the open collar.

ROUND 10: Continue with same colour yarn. Sl st into next stitch, to create opening for collar. Ch2, hdc in every stitch around (31)

ROUND 11: Continue with same colour yarn. Ch3, turn your work, dc into same stitch, hdc into every stitch around. In last stitch of round dc, ch3 and sl st to join into same stitch. Ch1 to finish and cut your colour of yarn..

**Turn your jumper inside out, weave your ends to the inside of jumper.*

MAKING THE SLEEVES

ROUND 1: To begin make a fsc row of 10 stitches. (or chain 11, single crochet into second chain from the hook and work a row of sc into every stitch) Join with a slip st. Use your tail to join the last chain with the first ch. (10)

Now to work in the round..

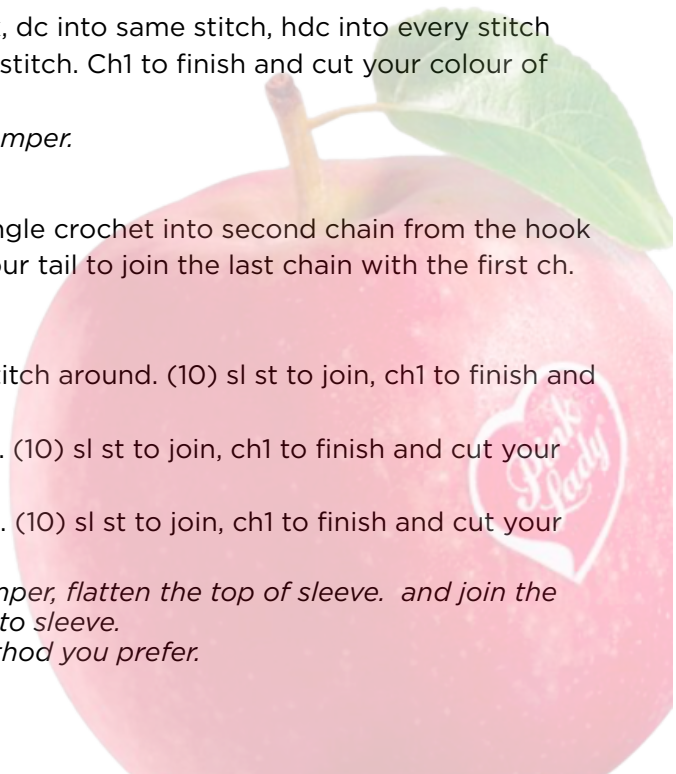
ROUND 2: Join new colour yarn (if desired). Ch2, hdc in every stitch around. (10) sl st to join, ch1 to finish and cut your colour of yarn.

ROUND 3: Join new colour yarn. Ch2, hdc in every stitch around. (10) sl st to join, ch1 to finish and cut your colour of yarn.

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**Make 2x sleeves the same. Align row colour to main body of jumper, flatten the top of sleeve. and join the two edges to jumper with darning needle. Push loose ends up into sleeve.*

Alternatively, leave top of sleeve open and attach whichever method you prefer.



UK TERMS JUMPER #1

WHAT YOU WILL NEED:

Your chosen colour palette of DK yarns. Customise as you please!

4mm crochet hook

Darning needle/Finishing needle



This pattern is written in UK terms.

ABBREVIATIONS:

mc - magic circle.

tr - treble crochet.

htc - half treble crochet.

ch - chain.

dc - double crochet.

sl st - slip stitch.

st - stitch.

fdc - foundation double crochet.

WHAT TO DO:

Creating the base of the jumper.

Start with an mc. (or ch3 and sl st to first chain).

ROUND 1: Ch3, 11 tr into mc, sl st to join. (12)

ROUND 2: Continue with same colour yarn. Ch2, 1htc in same stitch, 2htc in every stitch around. sl st to join. (24)

ROUND 3: Continue with same colour yarn. Ch2, htc in same st, *(htc, htc, 2htc) *repeat from to end of round. (32). Sl st to join,

**The first 3 rounds create the base of your apple jumper. Now to build the body and sleeves.*

Creating the body of the jumper.

ROUND 4: Continue with same colour yarn. Ch2, htc in every stitch around (32) sl st to join, ch1 to finish and cut your colour of yarn.

ROUND 5: Join new colour yarn. Ch2, htc in every stitch around (32) sl st to join, ch1 to finish and cut your colour of yarn.

ROUND 6: Join new colour yarn. Ch2, htc in every stitch around (32) sl st to join, ch1 to finish and cut your colour of yarn.

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Creating the open collar.

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ROUND 11: Continue with same colour yarn. Ch3, turn your work, tr into same stitch, htc into every stitch around. In last stitch of round work a tr, ch3 and sl st to join into same stitch. sl st to join, Ch1 to finish and cut your colour of yarn.

**Turn your jumper inside out, weave your ends into the inside of jumper.*
